FUNDING OPPORTUNITY: NURSING PROGRAM



DESCRIPTION: Because of the critical shortage of skilled nurses throughout America, South Florida Bible College and Theological Seminary (SFBC&TS), subject to funding, will establish a Nursing Program. When this program is fielded, students will be able to graduate with a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN). South Florida hospitals and medical clinics will be the primary beneficiaries of this influx

of nurses. A start-up period consists of three phases over five years.



PHASE 1: SFBC&TS' current accreditation is through The Association for Biblical Higher Education. We must acquire additional accreditation through The Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges and approval by the State of Florida to launch a Nursing Program. This phase with the help of consultants and current staff is estimated to take two years from the time of funding. Total Phase 1 cost is \$100,000.

PHASE 2: Library expansion, Nursing Program academic area creation and equipping, and staff and curriculum ramp-up. This phase is estimated to take a year with the help of consultants and current staff. Total Phase 2 cost is \$900,000.

PHASE 3: Two years of Nursing Program pilot operations, advertising, and an adequate funding contingency to cover unexpected costs. Total Phase 3 cost is \$1,000,000.

RECOGNITION: Donor recognition (subject to Board approval) is available.
