Brief Bio

I was born in San Francisco, CA and raised in the San Francisco Bay Area. I have been married to Raymond Droll for almost 37 years. He works in Information Systems for Sutter Health. We have three daughters, and a grandson. My grandfather crossed from Guadalajara, Mexico into the U.S. in the early 30s to build a life in San Francisco with my grandmother. I am the eldest grandchild of about 80 descendants of Alfonso and Transita Minero. Being raised in the Mexican culture has facilitated learning to speak Spanish and Portuguese with a degree of competence.

The organization I founded, Kairos Global Missions, has had 501 (c)(3) non-profit status in the U. S. since 2012. We have been serving needs in West Africa (the repair of boreholes) and are currently beginning a partnership with the International Justice Missions. We are engaged in raising awareness among the churches and among vulnerable women of the brothel population of Ghana regarding human trafficking. We are preparing a campus for the discipleship/recovery and vocational training of women who want to leave drug use or who need an alternative to working in the brothels. We have laid the foundation of the recovery home on our 5 acre campus in Ghana, and are proceeding to Phase II of the building project.
