SCHOLARSHIP

The William Parker Herring, Jr. Scholarship is an entrance scholarship for domestic students entering the Master of Arts in Christian Counseling.

QUALIFICATIONS/REQUIREMENTS FOR THE WILLIAM PARKER HERRING SCHOLARSHIP FUND ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- Voted on, BEFORE each semester.
- Be a prospective SFBC graduate student entering in the Master in Christian Counseling program
- Maintain a minimum GPA of 3.5
- Evidence of financial need for the scholarship
- Three reference letters
Acceptable letters should come from church leaders (i.e., pastor, elder, minister), professional affiliates such as a supervisor, and/or academic reference.
- Completion of a 700–1000-word essay, double-spaced answering the following questions:
 1. What inspired you to seek a degree in the field of counseling?
 2. How will this scholarship help you fulfill your God-given purpose in the field of counseling?
 3. What difference will this scholarship make in your educational pursuit?
 4. Share your life Bible verse and the impact it has made in your life.

*Recipients of the scholarship must complete the required 1-year enrollment period in the Master's in Christian Counseling program.
