Mission statement

South Florida Bible College & Theological Seminary (SFBC&TS) is an institution of higher learning where the Bible is central in preparing men and women for ministry to serve Christ and His Church through Biblical thought and Christian life.

History

SFBC&TS was established in 1985 by Dr. Joseph Guadagnino. The Founder and first President, Dr. Joseph Guadagnino, moved to Chancellor at the beginning of 2016, and the Board of Directors inaugurated the Institution's second President, Dr. Mary Drabik. Her history extends from the early days of the Institution.

SFBC&TS was founded to prepare dedicated men and women for service to the Lord through quality Christian education. The Lord has richly blessed our efforts through the years, and in 2015, SFBC&TS celebrated its thirtieth year in the Lord's service. SFBC&TS provides theological education where Biblical standards of Christian faith and life are established and maintained. This is accomplished through: quality instruction, the study of theological concepts, cultivation of a spiritual life, and performance of Christian service.


Many SFBC&TS graduates achieve success as teachers, administrators, youth ministers, missionaries, pastors, counselors, as well as obtain accomplishments in other professions. Whether attending part-time or full-time on campus or through distance learning, students can fulfill God's educational plans for their lives while, at the same time, spreading the Gospel to non-believers and sharing the love of Jesus with fellow Christians.

Operating Highlights

For over 30 years, SFBC&TS has flourished because it has remained faithful to God's vision: "To equip committed men and women for Christian service." Below are highlights of this Academic Year:

- God completely surprised us this year, in August 2017, we signed a lease moving to a new facility approximately one mile from our previous location! This new facility of 50,000 sq. ft. now houses our new state of the art Steven R. Sylvester Memorial Library.
- A grant was received from the Harcourt M. & Virginia W. Sylvester Foundation for \$150,000 to completely renovate our library.
- The Dedication of the Steven R. Sylvester Memorial Library and Founder's Hall, dedicated to our Chancellor and Founders, Dr. Joseph & Beatrice Guadagnino.
- SFBC&TS continues to be ranked in the top 10 most affordable Bible colleges accredited by The Association of Biblical Higher Education (ABHE) and is listed on the Affordable Colleges website.
- Approval for the Master of Arts in Pastoral Counseling and Doctor of Ministry Programs was achieved.
- A new website was designed and launched in the Spring of 2018.
- A total of 2,236 credit hours have been obtained by 537 Faith Farm Ministries (FFM) students equivalent to \$570,835 in free tuition. FFM is a free Christian, 9- month, residential addiction recovery program available to all of America.

Expansion Goals:

1. SFBC&TS has over 1,000 alumni serving in both Christian and Secular capacities locally and around the world.






Steven R. Sylvester Memorial Library

SFBC&TS Ministry Model

- As an inter-denominational institution, we *educate the student in the various evangelical doctrines and let the churches indoctrinate.*
- *A key distinction about our program is our commitment to affordable education.* Our students have the opportunity to graduate debt free as they go into ministry. Many students come from at-risk populations, and their lives are turned around by dedicated faculty and staff. The majority of our unique body of students comes from low-income households and diverse international ethnic backgrounds.
- **Bachelor of Arts Degree Programs:** Biblical Studies; Christian Counseling; Religious Education; Pastoral Ministry; and Christian Business Management.
- **Master of Arts Degree Programs:** Biblical Studies, Pastoral Counseling and Divinity.
- **Doctor of Ministry Program**
- Approximately 553 students are enrolled both on campus and through distance learning.
- Affordable education, with the goal of debt-free graduation, was realized by 66% of the SFBC&TS graduates.

Student Financial Aid

SFBC&TS is approved to offer Financial Aid. Veteran's benefits are also available to qualifying students including the Post 911 Bill. SFBC&TS is also approved by the State of Florida to offer Vocational Rehabilitation.





