

FUNDING OPPORTUNITY: English For Academic Purposes (EAP)

DESCRIPTION: South Florida Bible College and Theological Seminary (SFBC&TS) offers a one-year scholarship to an English language program that focuses on helping international and domestic students acquire the advanced competencies in academic English that will be necessary for them to enter an undergraduate degree program. The curriculum is based on an English language learning series from Oxford Publishing House - Wide Angle Series. EAP at SFBC&TS began in July 2016. Classes in writing, reading, speaking, and listening are offered four times a week with a total of 16 hours of classroom instruction. Curriculum is augmented through additional on campus activities that further prepares students mentally for college.

BENEFIT: Spanish, Portuguese, and French-based creole are common languages in South Florida where communities exist that these languages are primarily spoken. Furthermore, South Florida is known as an American entry point for international students seeking a student visa. Of note is that 20 countries are represented this 2022-2023 Academic Year at SFBC&TS. We are committed to seeking and assisting international or domestic students with English language proficiency. We provide them with the English competency, so they can excel and complete an undergraduate and perhaps graduate education enabling them to return to their communities as pastors and business leaders.

SCHOLARSHIP COST: \$6,000 300 SCHOLARSHIPS FULL PROGRAM Cost: \$1.8M (Scholarship Breakdown: Tuition, Books & Student Course Fees = \$5,500 + Administration = \$500)

RECOGNITION: Students receiving Scholarships will be known as "Donor Last Name" Scholars (Example = Smith Family Scholar) during their time in EAP. Donors will be invited to EAP social and graduation activities.
